# SERMON *notes*

## QUESTIONS ASKED BY DISCIPLES: WHY COULD WE NOT CAST IT OUT? MARK 9:28

### I. THE BEGINNING OF OUR FAITH.

- A. Faith is the assurance of things hoped for and the \_\_\_\_\_ (proof, evidence) of things unseen (Heb. 11:1).
- B. Our faith is based on evidence even though we did not see the \_\_\_\_\_ human form of Jesus (John 20:29).
- C. Our faith, as immature, weak and fragile as it might be, is \_\_\_\_\_ for our salvation (Matt. 18:3).

### II. GROWING IN OUR FAITH.

- A. The disciples had a question: Why could we not cast it out? You may hear it a different way today from your disciple: What If I have \_\_\_\_\_?
- B. Doubts are \_\_\_\_\_ to discovering answers: Ask the question, search for the answer. *When a disciple asks you a question...stop, listen and answer.*
- C. We are put in situations that call for a choice: depend on ourselves or \_\_\_\_\_ (Mark 6:7, 13)?
- D. Even with our small, fragile, mustard seed of faith, talking to God communicates our dependence on Him and His \_\_\_\_\_ starts to flow.
